Revised Leave Entitlement

Permanent Secretaries and Heads of Department are hereby advised that approval has been given for the implementation of a revised leave structure for new entrants to the Public Service with effect from the 1st January 2002. A Schedule of the new structure is attached.

It was initially proposed to introduce a revised leave structure for serving members of the Civil Service. However, arising out of discussions with the Trade Unions and Staff Associations representing Public Service employees and in consultation with the Office of the Solicitor General it was decided that the new leave structure should be applied to persons entering the Service with effect from the 1st January 2002. Persons employed in the Service up to and including the 31st December 2001 will therefore

continue to earn leave in keeping with the terms of their employment as provided for in Chapter 5 of the 1976 Staff Orders for the Public Service and the relevant Circulars amending leave from time to time issued by the Ministry with responsibility for the Public Service.

In any case of doubt or difficulty the Conditions of Service Section of the Ministry of Finance and Planning should be contacted for clarification.
