Permanent Secretaries and Heads of Departments are hereby advised that the Motor Car Allowance which is paid to the officers in the positions listed in the attached schedule has been increased from \$320,028 per annum to \$341,220 per annum with effect from June 1, 2002 as an interim measure.

An officer who operates a partially maintained Government Motor Car should be paid 50% of the above rate, that is \$170,610 per annum with effect from June 1, 2002.

Please be advised that an officer holding the specified post to which the motor car allowance of \$341,220 per annum is attached but who does not possess a motor vehicle is to receive an allowance of \$136,488 per annum with effect from June 1, 2002.

Provided funds are available, the new rates may now be paid.
