Re: Second Amendment to Circular #18 –Procedure for Termination of Assignment of Vehicles to Persons in the System at the level of SEG 4 to SEG 6 or Equivalent

The attention of Permanent Secretaries and Heads of Departments and Agencies is hereby invited to Circular No. 18 dated August 4, 2003 and Circular No. 20 dated September 16, 2003, which outlined the procedure for termination of assignment of vehicles to persons in the system at the level of SEG 4 to SEG 6 or equivalent.

Please be advised of the following additional amendments:

Delete from Paragraph 4.3 the following sentence:

"However he/she shall not be entitled to the special loan facility."

and insert the following sentence:

"A Contract Officer may opt to purchase the vehicle assigned to him/her by a repayment schedule over the remaining life of his/her current contract period".

Add the following sub-section immediately following sub-section 4.3:

Where the repayment schedule cannot effect full discharge of the outstanding balance within the remaining contract period, then the gratuity payable to the officer must be applied to effect full settlement of the outstanding balance. In contract officer at the time of the loan repayment negotiations that the settlement of the outstanding balance on the loan.
