Re: 2006/08 Revision of Salaries TSS/HS

Consequent on the Memorandum of Understanding signed between the Government of Jamaica and the Jamaica Confederation of Trade Unions (JCTU) the attached schedule details increased salaries and sessional rates for the captioned group with effect from April 1, 2006 and April 1, 2007.

The new rates are payable with effect from June 1, 2006. Retroactive amounts for the period April 1 to May 31, 2006 are to be paid in July 2006.


The additional cost to implement the revised rates and pay the retroactive amounts must be submitted to the Public Expenditure Division and the Compensation Unit of the Ministry of Finance and Planning. The information should detail the number of positions involved at each grade\level.

The Temporary MOU allowance paid in May 2006 is to be recovered from the retroactive amounts to be paid in July 2006.

Please note that the Temporary MOU allowance paid in April 2006 is NOT TO BE RECOVERED.

Loan payments for persons who opted for the moratorium are to resume in June 2006. For loans disbursed by the Accountant General's Department the calculation of interest is also to resume as of that date.

In any case of doubt or difficulty the Compensation Unit, Public Service Establishment Division of this Ministry should be contacted before any payments are made.
