COMPUTER LOANS

Reference is made to this Ministry's Circular No. 11 dated September 3, 1998 concerning the availability of funds for Civil Servants to purchase personal computers – a copy of the 1998 circular is attached for ease of reference.

Please note that officers who have received loans five (5) years ago and over may obtain a second loan. The form to be used in applying for the loan has been revised to allow for the expeditious completion of the application process and to accommodate second loan applicants. A copy of the revised application form is attached.

Previous applicants who have not yet received approval are now asked to re-apply as only applications submitted on the attached form will be considered at the next Computer Loan Committee Meeting.

The following conditions are applicable to this loan provision:

- loans can now be accessed up to a maximum of Fifty Thousand
 Dollars (\$50,000.00) subject to the applicant's ability to repay the loan;
- (ii) the loan will be recovered over a 3 year period and interest at the rate of eight percent (8%) per annum on the reducing balance the interest is to be paid quarterly; and
- (iii) two (2) sureties will be required.

The loan application forms must be duly completed before the applications can be considered. The Special Benefits Unit, Public Service Establishment Division should be contacted for any clarification.

Consequent on the agreement reached with the Jamaica Civil Service Association, Permanent Secretaries, and Heads of Departments are being advised that funds have been made available for Civil Servants to be granted loans for the purchase of personal computers. Loans will be accommodated only to the extent of the amount provided for this purpose.

Loans can now be accessed up to a maximum of Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000.00) subject to the applicant's ability to repay the loan. The loan will be recovered over a three (3) year period and interest at the rate of eight percent (8%) per annum on the reducing balance should be paid quarterly. A minimum of two (2) sureties will be required.

Interested persons may apply on the application form attached through their Ministries/Departments to the Public Service Establishment Division of the Ministry of Finance and Planning at the above address. Ministries/Departments should state the applicants' indebtedness to the Government (if any) when submitting the application together with evidence of the proposed purchase and cost.
