Procurement of Motor Vehicles

Permanent Secretaries, Chief Executive Officers and Heads of Departments are hereby advised that Cabinet has decided to discontinue the restriction on the procurement of motor vehicles to critical emergency services as outlined in Cabinet Decision No. 13/09 dated 26th March, 2009 and Cabinet Decision No.18/10 dated 10th May, 2010.

Consequently, by Cabinet Decision No. 16/11 dated 11th April, 2011 the restriction on the procurement of vehicles by Government Entities to emergency services has been officially discontinued with effect from April 11, 2011 and thereafter the standard Government of Jamaica procurement and financing procedures apply.

Permanent Secretaries, Chief Executives Officers and Heads of Departments are asked to ensure that the instructions contained in this Circular are brought to the attention of all concerned for compliance.
