Re: Cash Payment Limit

Permanent Secretaries and Heads of Departments and Agencies are hereby advised that Instruction number 5.8 under the Financial Administration and Audit Act Instructions is being amended to read as follows:

5.8 The payment of public moneys in cash shall be restricted to a limit of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000.00). This limit on cash payments shall not apply to payments in respect of salaries and wages. All payments in excess of the approved limit shall be made by cheque or through the Central Treasury Management/Treasury Single Account System (CTMS/TSA) when implemented.

Permanent Secretaries and Heads of Departments and Agencies are reminded that if it becomes necessary to increase the level of any petty cash imprest, prior approval must be obtained in accordance with Ministry of Finance and Planning (MoF&P) Circular No. 3, File No. 107/022 dated January 24, 2005.
