## Re: Amendment to the C.I.F Upper Limit for the Purchase of Motor Vehicles

Permanent Secretaries, Chief Executive Officers and Heads of Departments are hereby advised that the upper limit for assigned motor vehicles and the 20% Duty Concession has been increased effective June 1, 2016.

Cabinet by Decision No. 16/16 dated May 16, 2016, approved amendment to the upper limit for purchase of motor vehicles to Forty-one Thousand United States Dollars (US\$41,000.00) Cost, Insurance and Freight (CIF) for public officials eligible for assigned motor vehicles and those entitled to the 20% Duty Concession.

Notwithstanding this amendment to the upper limit, Ministries, Departments and Agencies should continue to exercise prudence and cost containment in the interest of optimizing public expenditure in procuring assigned motor vehicles.

Permanent Secretaries, Chief Executive Officers and Head of Departments are asked to ensure that the instructions contained in this Circular are brought to the attention of all concerned for compliance.
