ANNEX

Requirements to be met by foreign students applying for scholarships to pursue studies in Cuba:

a) Under 25 years of age.

b) Education level equivalent to Cuban senior high school.

c) Member of a low-income family unable to finance his/her studies, preferably from rural areas.

d) Health certificate including negative HIV test results. For females, a

non-pregnancy certificate is required.

e) Document certifying that the student has no criminal record.

Cuba does not assume the international transportation expenses that this scholarship requires. The cost of students' international transportation, whatever the reason, shall be borne by the Jamaican counterparts.

Required documents for the student's record once approved:

a) Copy of secondary education certificate.

b) Copy of transcripts from the last year of secondary education.

c) Original health certificate, including negative HIV test results. For females, a non-pregnancy certificate is required.

d) Original police records.

e) Ten (10) ID photographs (1cm x 1cm).

f) Scholarship Allocation form, original, filled, signed and stamped.

g) Original birth certificate.

h) Code of Ethics signed by the student.
