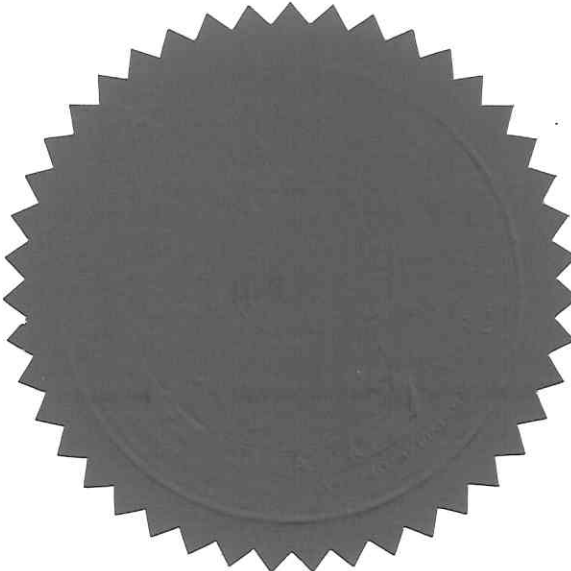

AN ACT to Amend the Appropriation Act, 2024 to exclude all expenditure classified as statutory expenditure; and for connected matters.

[13th day of April 2024]

BE IT ENACTED by The King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Jamaica, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation (Amendment) Act, 2024 and shall be read and construed as one with the Appropriation Act, 2024 (hereinafter referred to as the "principal Act") and all amendments thereto. Short title and construction.

2. Section 2 of the principal Act is amended by deleting the words “eight hundred and forty-nine billion, eight hundred and ninety-six million, four hundred and seventy-one thousand dollars” and substituting therefor the words “eight hundred and seventeen billion, two hundred and sixty-five million, two hundred and forty-two thousand dollars”.
