

AN ACT to Amend the Appropriation Act, 2024 to exclude all expenditure classified as statutory expenditure; and for connected matters.

[13th day of april 2024

BE IT ENACTED by The King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Jamaica, and by the authority of the same, as follows:---

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation (Amendment) Act, Short title 2024 and shall be read and construed as one with the Appropriation and construction. Act, 2024 (hereinafter referred to as the "principal Act") and all amendments thereto.

Amendment of section 2 of principal Act. 2. Section 2 of the principal Act is amended by deleting the words "eight hundred and forty-nine billion, eight hundred and ninety-six million, four hundred and seventy-one thousand dollars" and substituting therefor the words "eight hundred and seventeen billion, two hundred and sixty-five million, two hundred and forty-two thousand dollars".

Amendment of Schedule to principal Act.

- 3. Column II of the Schedule to the principal Act is amended—
 - (a) by deleting the sums granted in relation to the Heads of Expenditure set out below and substituting therefor the following sums specified in relation thereto—



AN ACT to apply a sum out of the Consolidated Fund to the service of the year ending on the 31st day of March, 2025, and to appropriate the sums granted in this Session of Parliament.

[28th day of March 2024]

BE IT ENACTED by The King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Jamaica, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act, 2024.

Short title.

Expenditures authorized.

2. The Accountant-General may, on the warrant of the Minister, issue out of the Consolidated Fund, a sum not exceeding in the aggregate, eight hundred and forty-nine billion, eight hundred and ninety-six million, four hundred and seventy-one thousand dollars as specified in Column II of the Schedule, for defraying the several charges and expenses of the Government of Jamaica, for the financial year ending the 31st day of March, 2025.

Appropriation.

- 3.—(1) The sum granted by section 2 is hereby appropriated to defray the charges of the services and purposes as specified in Column I of the Schedule, pursuant to and in accordance with, subsection (1) of section 116 of the Constitution of Jamaica, and shall be deemed to have been so appropriated from the 1st day of April, 2024.
- (2) In addition to the said sum granted out of the Consolidated Fund, accounting officers may apply out of any money, whether received by way of fee, penalty, proceeds of sale, or by way of extra or unusual receipt, as appropriations-in-aid of the Heads of Expenditure as specified in Column I of the Schedule, in the sums respectively set out in Column III of the Schedule.
