The Ministry of Finance and the Public Service (MOFPS), through the Transformation Implementation Unit (TIU) is equipping public sector workers with the skills to thrive in a digital era through its Reskilling, Upskilling and New-skilling (RUN) Project.

The RUN project allows eligible employees within the Government of Jamaica (GOJ) to choose from over 7,000 self-paced online courses ranging from 30 minutes to several weeks in length. This project is aligned with the public sector transformation vision which is geared at creating a modern public service that is fair, values people and consistently delivers high-quality services.

Reskilling is for GOJ employees who would like to acquire a skill in areas such as business administration, make-up artistry or to improve their soft skills, upskilling targets employees who wish to acquire additional skills or new credentials to progress their career. Finally, New-skilling is geared towards employees who wish to access refined training in specific areas that will elevate their service delivery.
