

TERTIARY GRANT FOR CHILDREN OF PUBLIC SECTOR WORKERS

Every young Jamaican, regardless of their socio-economic background, deserves access to a tertiary education.

As such, the Tertiary Grant for Children of Public Sector Workers offered through the Ministry of Finance and the Public Service (MOFPS) offers financial assistance to children of public sector employees who are pursuing tertiary studies for a given academic period.

For first-time applicants, the grant covers tuition costs only up to \$150,000 and may be awarded to the parent of the recipient once every 3 years. The grant applies to children of public sector workers not older than 25 years old, who have been accepted to pursue or are pursuing local full-time accredited programmes at a tertiary institution registered by the University Council of Jamaica (UCJ).

The application becomes open from July to August annually and interested persons can apply via the Ministry's website at mof.gov.jm.

- ▶ The Tertiary Grant for Children of Public Sector Workers is offered through the MOFPS.
- ▶ The grant covers tuition costs only up to \$150,000.
- ▶ The grant is applicable to new and returning students who are pursuing local full-time accredited programmes at an institution registered with the UCJ.
- Tenable for tertiary studies only.
- Applications are accepted via an online application form on the Ministry's website at mof.gov.jm.
