NEW FINANCING OPPORTUNITIES

FOR SMALL BUSINESSES - JSE



Access to financing has become more inclusive for Jamaica's small business sector with the launch of the **Jamaica Stock Exchange (JSE) Micro Market**. The new **equity capital platform is designed specifically for Micro, Small and Medium-sized Enterprises (MSMEs)** that are not yet eligible to list on the Junior or Main Markets.

Through the Micro Market, eligible businesses can raise equity capital ranging from approximately J\$50 million to J\$100 million, providing a structured pathway for smaller enterprises to access investment funding, expand their operations and accelerate growth.

The initiative forms part of broader efforts to deepen Jamaica's capital market, strengthen financial inclusion and support MSME development. It allows emerging businesses to access equity financing while maintaining appropriate standards of investor protection, governance and transparency.



WHAT'S IN IT FOR ME?

- The JSE Micro Market gives eligible businesses a more accessible route to raising investment capital, allowing them to expand their operations, enter the export market, retire debt and increase their contribution to Jamaica's economy.
- The Ministry of Finance and the Public Service continues to support initiatives that expand financial inclusion and unlock growth opportunities for Jamaican enterprises.



WHAT YOU SHOULD REMEMBER:

- The JSE Micro Market enables eligible MSMEs to raise between J\$50 million and J\$100 million in equity capital.
- It is designed for smaller businesses that are not yet eligible for the Junior or Main Markets.
- The initiative supports business growth, increased investment opportunities and potential job creation.
