

\$150,000 GRANTS FOR PUBLIC OFFICERS

The Government of Jamaica (GOJ) is committed to strengthening the public service by investing in human capital development that support both the personal and professional growth of public sector employees. To this end, the Ministry of Finance and the Public Service (MOFPS), offers grants of up to \$150,000 to eligible public servants in pursuit of their educational goals and professional development. This initiative is part of the Government's ongoing commitment

to building a more skilled, motivated and high-performing public sector.

To qualify, eligible public officers must be permanently appointed or temporary with at least two years' continuous service. Newly accepted and returning students must be enrolled at an institution accredited with the University Council of Jamaica. The grant, which is offered annually, covers tuition costs only. It applies to tertiary-level students, institutions authorized to offer certifications, and students pursuing CSEC and CAPE subjects.

WHAT YOU SHOULD REMEMBER:

- Public officers who are permanently appointed or temporarily employed with at least two years of continuous service, are eligible for the grant
- ➤ The grant covers up to \$150,000 in tuition costs, certification courses as well as CSEC and CAPE subjects.
- ► The application period is open from mid-July to August annually and applicants must apply via the associated link on the Ministry's website at mof.gov.jm.
