## OWNING GOJ ASSETS THROUGH PUBLIC AUCTION

The general public has the opportunity to bid on a wide variety of government assets at competitive prices through the Ministry of Finance and the Public Service's Public Auction. **The quarterly auction allows the public to bid on serviceable and unserviceable assets that have been removed from operational use.**

Bidding items include office furniture, fixtures, electrical appliances, motor vehicles and more. **Any member of the public can participate in the auction; however, participants must register with the Jamaica Customs Agency (JCA) to receive a unique bidder's number.** The registration criteria **include** 2 passport-size photographs, TRN, valid ID and a registration fee of JMD\$2000.

### WHAT YOU SHOULD REMEMBER

- Anyone can participate in the GOJ Public Auction.
- You must register with the JCA and receive a unique bidder's number.
- Your JCA bidder's number can also be used to participate in auctions conducted by the Jamaica Constabulary Force (JCF) and the Jamaica Customs Agency (JCA).
- The list of all available assets is published at [mof.gov.jm](http://mof.gov.jm).
- Auction notices are issued quarterly in local newspapers and shared on the Ministry's official social media platforms.
