

Chevening Scholarship Announcement 2021

The British High Commission is now inviting applications for Chevening Scholarships, please see below information blurb and attached leaflets on how to access this opportunity.

Chevening, is the United Kingdom's fully funded international awards programme aimed at developing global leaders. It offers a unique opportunity for future leaders, influencers, and decision-makers from all over the world to study for a master's degree at any of the UK's world leading universities.

The Scholarship applications opened on August 3, 2021 and closes on November 2, 2021.

To be eligible for the scholarship, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- They must have least a first degree
- They must have two years working experience (which includes voluntary, internships, paid and unpaid work)
- They must have a commitment to return to Jamaica to contribute to the country's development.
- Must be at least 18 years. There is no upper age limit

Chevening is a fully funded scholarship that covers:

- Tuition fees
- A monthly living allowance
- An economy class return airfare to the UK
- Additional grants and allowances to cover essential expenditure

There is **no upper age limit** for persons interested in applying to Chevening and there are **no restrictions on the area of study** one can do.

Persons interested in doing an MBA should be aware that there is financial cap of £22,000. This means that if you are interested in doing an MBA, Chevening will only cover up to £22,000 for the tuition. This financial cap only applies to MBAs. Masters of Science and Masters of Arts programmes or other postgraduate degrees do not have a financial cap.

Eligible Courses - In order to be eligible, the courses you choose must be full-time, and:

- Start in the autumn term (usually September/October)
- Taught master's (i.e. not research-focused MRes programmes)
- Lead to a master's degree qualification
- Based in the UK

Courses cannot be:

- *Part-time*
- *Distance learning*
- *Less than nine months in duration*
- *More than 12 months in duration*
- *PhD or DPhil*
- *Taught with more than one month of study outside the UK*
