## Kilometre (Mileage) Rates

Consequent on the agreement reached with the Jamaica Confederation of Trade Unions (JCTU) regarding certain items flowing from the restructured Compensation for the Public Sector, the effective date of the Kilometre (Mileage) Rates is adjusted to April 1, 2022.

The retroactive increase of the Kilometre (Mileage) Rate is payable to Officers who claimed Kilometre (Mileage) rates for the period April 1, 2022 to November 30, 2022. Kilometre Rates are as detailed below:

## Kilometre (Mileage) Rates

	Item	Rate per km \$	With effect from
1.	Motor Vehicle	100.00	April 1, 2022
2.	Motorcycle	54.00	April 1, 2022

Where claims for Kilometre (Mileage) Rates were being held by the Finance and Accounts sections of Ministries, Departments and Agencies (MDAs), these must be verified by the Managers/Supervisors prior to the honouring of these claims. In this regard, the payment of applicable retroactive amounts is subject to the availability of funds and compliance with relevant legislation and Government of Jamaica guidelines.

Please note that the conditions for payment as outlined in this Ministry's Circular No. 22 dated December 29, 2022 entitled "Mileage Revisions" remains applicable. MDAs are also encouraged to review Circular No. 8 dated January 10, 2023 and Circular No. 28 dated October 20, 2023.
