Marcus Garvey Public Sector Graduate Scholarship Programme 2025/2026

Reference is made to Cabinet Decision No 26/20 in which approval was granted for the full funding of 150 Public Sector Workers to pursue Graduate level studies at approved institutions at a cost of \$1 billion over a period of 5 years commencing August 2021, under the Marcus Garvey Public Sector Graduate Scholarship Programme.

Applications are invited for the aforementioned Scholarship tenable for the September 2025/2026 academic year. The following guidelines should be followed:

- The desired thematic areas supported under the Marcus Garvey Scholarship 2025/2026:
 - a. IT/ICT/Cyber Security/Data Analytics
 - b. Climate Change (Environmental Management/Disaster Risk Management)
 - c. Education (Science/Technology/Engineering/Mathematics)
 - d. Engineering/Built Environment
 - e. Law, Public Policy & Administration
 - f. National Security
 - g. Public Health
 - h. Post Graduate Studies in Economics/Fiscal Policy
 - i. Post Graduate Studies in Public Financial Management
 - j. Post Graduate studies in Legal Drafting
- 2. The Scholarship is open to Public Sector Workers who:
 - a. Have been accepted to pursue local or overseas, full-time/part-time accredited programmes (Postgraduate/Masters/PhD) at a tertiary Institution listed among the approved Institutions for the Scholarship Programme. Pursuit of studies at a level already attained will not be supported:
 - b. Have a minimum of Second Class Honours or equivalent, or Transcript with GPA of at least 2.5 for PhD or 3.0 for Masters level programmes;
 - c. Are not recipients of other scholarships/financial assistance/grant processed through the Government of Jamaica/Ministry of Finance and the Public Service at the time of application;
 - d. Are 45 years old or younger at the time of application;
 - e. Have at least two (2) years of continuous service in the public sector,
 - f. Qualify for and can ordinarily access Study Leave from their Employer.

Applicants should:

- a. Visit the Ministry's website www.mof.gov.jm to create a profile and submit their application.
- Prepare to complete three (3) essays reflecting a Personal Statement, Study Plan and Implementation Plan (not less than 300 words).

 - a. Taxpayer Registration Number (TRN)
 - b. Copy of the Birth Certificate, Marriage Certificate (where applicable) certified by the Employee's HR/JP/Notary Public

Applications are invited for the 2025 Marcus Garvey Public Sector Graduate Scholarship to undertake Graduate Studies in approved Local and International Universities. Studies must be carried out on a full-time basis, and can be onsite, online or a combination of both, with effect from the Academic year 2025/26.

ELIGIBILITY

- Jamaican citizens permanently residing in Jamaica for at least three {3} years prior to application.
- Age 45 years or younger at the time of application.
- Applicants must apply to participating Universities to pursue their studies,
- Applicants must have already applied to a participating University with the eligibility to graduate in two (2) years from the date of the scholarship, or be accepted into a university to complete the degree in two (2) years.
- Have obtained a university degree on submission of their scholarship application (for graduate scholarships).
- Have at least two (2) years of continuous service to the GOJ and must ordinarily qualify for Study Leave.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS REQUIRED:

- Certified copies of transcripts of grades for all academic degrees completed
- Three (3) recommendation letters (Character, Employer, Academic)
- Certified Birth Certificate/Bio-data Page of Passport
- Medical Certificate
- Curriculum Vitae

BENEFITS

The Marcus Garvey Scholarship will cover 100% of tuition cost for programmes which must fall within the stipulated thematic areas at participating universities. The benefits vary and may include:

- Tuition and mandatory fees
- Miscellaneous & Book allowance
- Medical Insurance (where applicable)
- Round Trip ticket (Economy Class) at the beginning and end of Studies (where applicable)

OBLIGATION

Successful candidates will be required to enter into a Bond Agreement with the GOJ prior to the uptake of the Scholarship Award, giving an undertaking to work in the Public Sector for a specified period of time upon completion of studies.
