Establishment of National Contracts Commission (NCC) Specialist Sector Committees

The Ministry of Finance and Planning (MoFP) is now in the process of accepting applications from suitable qualified persons from within the Public *and Private* Sector to serve on the newly constituted Specialist Sector Committees (SSC).

This thrust is geared towards strengthening of the National Contracts Commission (NCC) review process for the award of government contracts and will replace the existing Sector Committees.

An evaluation of respondents will be conducted and those selected will be formally notified, thereafter a period of training and orientation is scheduled, the details of which will be communicated to all concerned.
