



UK Commonwealth Master's Scholarship: Jamaica Ministry of Finance and the Public Service

The Commonwealth Scholarship Commission in the UK (CSC) provides the UK government's Commonwealth scholarship scheme led by international development objectives. Since 1960, the CSC has funded over 30,000 individuals to study in the UK and gain skills, acquire knowledge and build networks to tackle global development challenges.

The CSC is open for applications between September 2, 2025 to October 14, 2025.

CSC Eligibility Criteria for Commonwealth Master's Candidates

To Apply For These Scholarships, You Must:

- Be a citizen of or have been granted refugee status by an eligible Commonwealth country, or be a British Protected Person
- Be a permanent resident in an eligible Commonwealth country
- Be available to start your academic studies in the UK by the start of the UK academic year in September 2026
- By September 2026, hold a first degree of at least upper second class (2:1) honours standard, OR a second-class degree (2:2). The CSC would not normally fund a second UK Master's degree.
- Be unable to afford to study in the UK without this scholarship
- Provide full transcripts detailing ALL your higher education qualifications including to-date transcripts for any qualifications you are currently studying (with certified translations if not in English) – uploaded to the online application system
- Provide references from at least two individuals: [One (1) Academic & One (1) Professional]

Agency Selection Criteria:

• Be able to meet all the immigration requirements of a tier 4 visa to study in the UK



Agency Deadlines:

• Ministry of Finance and the Public Service will be accepting applications via the CSC's link stated below from September 2, 2025 to October 14, 2025 11:AM Jamaica time. Please note the stated time is in keeping with the time the CSC's link closure.

How to Apply

• Candidates must apply using the CSC's online application system which can be found on the <u>CSC website</u>. Each scholarship has a 'How to apply' section which will have information and guidance on the application process and the link to the online application system. The CSC is unable to accept any applications not submitted via the online application system or after the closing date.
