NO GUARANTORS REQUIRED FOR SLB

No guarantor is required to access a loan from the Students' Loan Bureau (SLB). The Government of Jamaica (GOJ) has removed the guarantor requirement for all SLB applicants seeking to access tertiary financing, effective April 1, 2024.

This means more young Jamaicans from low-income households will now have the opportunity to complete their tertiary education through loan financing with the SLB without the need for a guarantor.



WHAT YOU SHOULD REMEMBER:



Effective April 1, 2024, applicants to the SLB will not require guarantors to access tertiary financing.



The GOJ is ensuring that every Jamaican who qualifies for university can access a loan.



An educated workforce will advance Jamaica's economy and by extension improve the socio-economic conditions of all Jamaicans.

- The removal of guarantors as a requirement for SLB applicants will give more Jamaicans an opportunity to finance their tertiary education.
