## ACCESS TIP November 2016

Under the Access to Information Act, a person commits an
offence if he alters or defaces, blocks or erases, destroys or
conceals an official document, to which a right of access has
been conferred under the Act, with the intention of preventing its disclosure.

- A fine of a maximum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) or six (6) months imprisonment or both could be applicable in those circumstances.
